06. RECLASSIFICATION OF LAND GLR SY. NO. 212 AREA 0.0020 ACRES, AHMEDNAGAR CANTONMENT.

Ref :- DEO, Pune circle, Pune letter no. ST / 105 / A'nagar / Enc / Gen / I, Dated : 15/06/2016.

As per site inspection of Sectional Engineer and Shri. Kamble, retired DEA representative visited the Survey 212 on 21 June 2016. As per DEO record the land 0.0020 acres (87.12 sq fts.) are used by Cantonment Board by encroachment of Drainage line. The DEO vide letter under reference directed to Cantonment Board to reclassification for encroached area only.

As per GLR of Survey No. 212, the total area is 0.810 acres (35283.60 sq. fts.) classified as B-4 Vacant land. The total area 0.810 acres may be considered for reclassification from B-4 to Class C, as there is main drain of Sadar Bazar going through this survey number and not used for any other purpose.

07. DETERMINATION OF EXPIRED LEASE IN RESPECT OF GLR SY. NO. 31-B, AHMEDNAGAR CANTONMENT (EXCISED AREA) AHMEDNAGAR CANTONMENT.

The DEO, Pune Circle, Pune vide letter under references asked the Cantonment Boards view, recommendation for the proposed use of the subject land for public / Cantonment Board purpose.

The Cantonment Board Senior Sectional Engineer and Shri. Kamble, retired DEA representative visited the survey no. 31 on 21 June 2016. As per site inspection, it is noticed that there is lot of encroachment and about 40-50 hotels on two road side and 5-6 residences pucca type. The encroachment is also pucca and double floors. These encroachments are very old.

Only after the Cantonment Board view, Necessary sanction of the Competent Authority for determination of the subject lease and on

determination its reclassification from class B-3 to Class C to be obtained.

The Cantonment Board May take the land of Survey No. 31-B area 4.23 acres in excised land after the removal of encroachment under the guidance of DEO, Pune Circle, Pune with the help of Cantonment Board, Army, Police authority, Ahmednagar Municipal Corporation etc.

08. DOOR TO DOOR GARBAGE COLLECTION FOR 2016-17 UNDER “SWACHH BHARAT ABHIYAAN”

Ref :- CBR No. 11, Dtd. - 10/05/2016

To consider and approve the requirement of fourth vehicle for door to door garbage collection in Cantonment area. This Board providing Door to door garbage collection services to the Cantonment Civil area every year by providing only three vehicles. Initially this service was provided purely on experimental basis. This is totally new concept, and due to that there was no any idea about the sufficient requirement of the vehicle to cover the all houses in door to door garbage collection services, and unfortunately it was continued, but it is very problematic to adjust the complete work in only three vehicle because the high density of houses and less nos. of vehicle.

The residencies of the Cantonment area required certain time to approach to the vehicle and deposit their rubbish in our door to door garbage collection will not be as desired.

The density of the houses and the availability of only three vehicles for door to door garbage collection services for approx 3500 houses (including civil area bungalow, and telephone colony) it could not be possible to cover the all houses in three vehicles. If we give 0.5 minute to each house for deposit their garbage in the door to door vehicle the time will be required 36 hrs for total 3500 houses in civil area including transportation of unloading at trenching ground, then after this door to door vehicles are goes to the trenching ground for unloading which is 06 km apart from the civil area and it will take 45

minutes approx for one trip. Each vehicle need to be completed two trips every day, it means 01:30 hour will be required for transportation. 06 hrs will be requiring for 04 vehicles for unloading. If one vehicle work for 08 hrs unloading and if one vehicle work for 08 hrs including transportation then 04:50 i.e. 05 vehicles will be required to provide satisfactory door to door garbage collection services.

As per above CBR the Board have approved the lowest rate of Rs. 49,500/- per vehicle per month for four vehicle quoted by M/s. Balaji Enterprises, Ahmednagar and accordingly after necessary procedure this office have issued work order to contractor to engage four vehicles for door to door garbage collection and contractor have started work from 08/06/2016 as per the above CBR, it has resolved that Board will review the necessity of the fourth vehicle after one month which will completed on 08/07/2016.

Now Board allocated the work to four door to door vehicles as under.

01.Area for ghanta gadi no. 01.

North side of N. H. 222 up to Bhingar nalaha. West side of including brahmingalli of Bhingar civil area including up to crimination ground, Moumin gilli, Gadekar galli, Patil galli, Mulan galli, Dane galli, Sonsale galli, Rangar galli, Wagaskar galli, Dapkar galli, Shopes near shivaji garden.

02.Area for ghanta gadi no. 02.

East side of Brahmin galli up to Bhingar tekdi west side including sadikmala, Mal galli, Laghuwetan society, Mulay galli, Berad galli, Lohar galli, Sarpan galli, Joshi galli, Lakar galli, Sukleshwar colony.

03.Area for ghanta gadi no. 03.

East side of Bhingar tekdi, Sahumaharaj Colony, Nehru Colony, Khaliwadi, Mahatma Colony, Laxmi Nagar, Dr. Ambedkar Colony, Sweeper quarters entire ward no. 07.

04.Area for ghanta gadi no. 04.

Sr. No. 76 shopping Complex area, Post and telephone colony, Near fort bungalows, Potinger road civil bungalows, Near club., Irani road bungalows and entire area of ward no. 03 & 02 including sport complex shops. The working period of above vehicles will be 07:00 am to 12:00 pm. & 01:00 pm to 04:00 pm every day (12:00 pm to 01:00 pm lunch period)

The above schedule of the transportation of the door garbage collection vehicle may be change as per requirement / as per direction of the Chief Executive Officer.

Proprietor of “PEOPLE FOR ANIMALS AHMEDNAGAR” requesting for use old animal clinic room at stored yard for treating stray, pet and injured animals. They stated that the above named firm is working on national level reputed firm and they worked in this field from 2015 on national level and now they wanted to start this facility in Ahmednagar district.

11. STERILIZATION OF DOGS IN CANTONMENT AREA

To consider and discuss in details and approve the matter of stray dogs in Cantonment civil area as at present there is no existing mechanism with the Board to control the stray dogs.

This office called a tender lot of time but there was no any response and due to that day by day lot of stray dogs increased in civil area.

One firm namely “PEOPLES FOR ANIMALS” Ahmednagar affiliated PEOPLES FOR ANIMALS, Delhi applied for the same work and given their rates for Catching, Sterilization, Immunization, Feeding and Release at 700/- per dogs. They request for creation demand of materials / infrastructure as under.

12. ALLOTMENT OF LAND ON TEMPORARY LICENSE BASIS FOR RUNNING JUICE STALL AT SY NO. 76.

The Cantonment Board vide above referred CBR has resolved to allot an open piece of land admeasuring 25' X 10' = 250 sq. fts. to Shri. Ganesh Laxman Shinde near nallaha at Sy. No. 76, accordingly agreement was drawn and other necessary formalities were completed under the authority of the above referred CBR, but the site was not physically handed over to the party.

Now the party again vide his application dated 13/06/2016 has requested to allot the said site of land on license basis.

The Board may decide to allot the land on temporary License under the authority of Rule 39 of CLAR 1937 and section 265 of the Cantonment Act 2006 at present STR rates.
